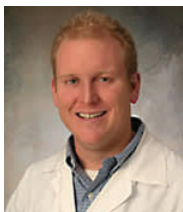

#### **Kyle Hogarth, MD**

Director of Bronchoscopy

Dr. Kyle Hogarth is an expert in pulmonary diseases--including alpha-1 antitrypsin (AAT) deficiency and sarcoidosis. He is also involved with the minimally invasive diagnosis and staging of lung cancer through bronchoscopy. Dr. Hogarth was one of the first doctors in Illinois to work with the superDimension/InReach System--an electromagnetic navigation system that uses 3-D imaging technology to detect and biopsy lung cancer.

Dr. Hogarth's research focuses on improving quality of life and outcomes for patients with AAT deficiency and lung cancer. He is an investigator in numerous clinical trials for these diseases.

New appointments for alpha one are scheduled for 2 hours.

In 2007, he received the Department of Medicine's Outstanding Junior Faculty Clinical Service Award. In addition to his clinical and research work, Dr. Hogarth is a manuscript reviewer for *Chest--The Journal of the American College of Chest Physicians* and serves on their Editorial Board, *Proceedings of the American Thoracic Society*, *European Respiratory Journal*, *Lung Cancer and Respiratory Research*.
